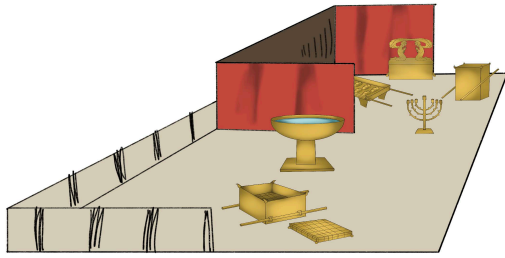


Praying Through the Tabernacle

Gate of Salvation

We must enter through the gate of salvation! There is only one way to God, by the way of salvation.

Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise!

Psalm 100:4

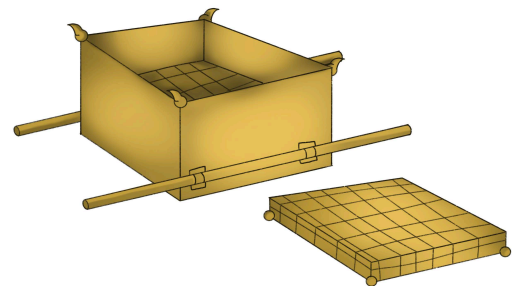
Praise Him for the blood of Jesus and the victory that the places He bled won for you.

- Sweat - Redeemed your willpower
- Stripes - Healing
- Crown of Thorns - Resources
- Hands - Blessings over the works of your hands
- Feet - Dominion over where we tread
- Side - Revealed broken heart to redeem your joy
- Bruises - To heal your inner hurts

Praise Him because of who He is:

- Jehovah Rapha - Healer
- Jehovah Jireh - Provider
- Jehovah Nissi - Victory Banner
- Jehovah Tsidkenu - Our Righteousness
- Jehovah M'Kaddesh - Our Sanctifier
- Jehovah Shalom - Our Peace
- Jehovah Shammah - God who never leaves you nor forsakes you
- Jehovah Rohi - Our Shepherd

Brazen Altar is a place of sacrifice and worship



- Repent for your sins
- Pray for righteousness
- Forgive others
- Pray for grace to love others unconditionally
- Seek humility and meekness

Laver represents Forgiveness and Sanctification



A place for examining yourself. Asking the Lord to show you areas of your life that need cleansing by His blood.

A time for setting yourself apart for God's purpose for your life.

Golden Lampstand represents the Holy Spirit



The Holy Spirit is our light and the one who guides us. He teaches, trains, and anoints us for God's divine purposes.

Thank him for His gifts: Word of wisdom, word of knowledge, faith, gift of healing, miracles, prophecy, discerning of spirits, tongues, and interpretation of tongues.

Seven Pipes Represent the Seven Spirits of God

- Spirit of Wisdom
- Spirit of Understanding
- Spirit of Counsel
- Spirit of Might
- Spirit of Knowledge
- Spirit of Fear of the Lord
- Spirit of Holiness

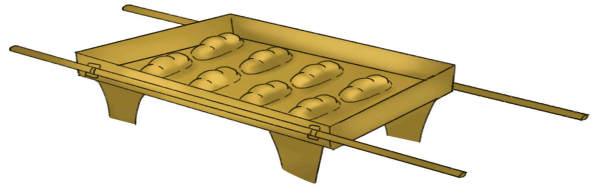
Table of Shewbread represents God's Word

12 loaves of fresh bread were placed daily in the tabernacle. We need to receive fresh daily bread from the Lord.

Thank Him for His word. Ask Him to allow His word to come alive and be fresh for you everyday.

Altar of Incense represents our prayers and worship being offered before God

The Altar of Incense is the place where we surrender our will for His.

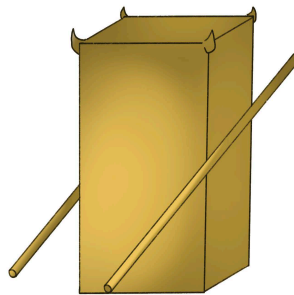
And we pray - God I lay my life down as a living sacrifice unto you. Not my will Lord but your's be done!

This is the place where Zechariah while performing his priestly duties took time to pray for his family. At this time we should pray for the needs of our family. As well as God's guidance and protection upon them.

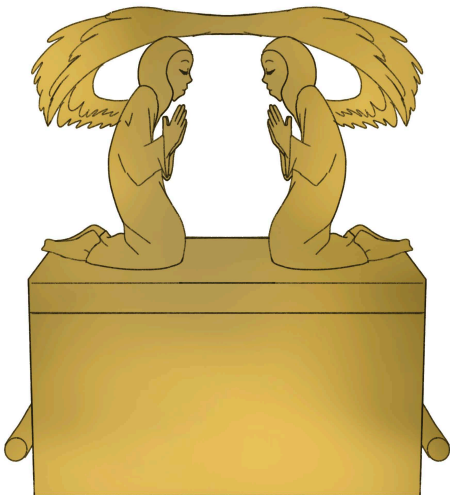
This is also the place where we take time to pray in the spirit. We allow the Holy Spirit to pray through us.

The Holy of Holies, The Ark of the Covenant and the Mercy Seat
